What have the Governors been involved with?

- Governor Day and Chair of Governors Day

Following a very successful Governor Day in May the Governors have reviewed the school improvement plan. Governors have also monitored the end of year, statutory and in house assessment. As a result the Governors have established a challenging School Improvement Plan which is focusing on:

- Handwriting and Spelling to improve writing
- Mental Maths to develop fluency and accuracy in calculations.

In addition to this the Governors have already supported parent evenings to engage with parents attending the parent consultations. Furthermore the Governors have conducted learning walks to explore the impact of Handwriting development within the first few weeks of the Autumn Term.

Governor Development

To further enable our school and other local schools to provide better outcomes for their pupils, the Governors are establishing a network of Governors from various local primary schools.

Governor Support to Families

With a significantly high proportion of pupils having dyslexia the Governors have agreed to support families in need with Dyslexia assessments to enable them to support their children more effectively.

Various Governors have already visited school to support the classes they are attached to and to support the curriculum eg Science visits.
