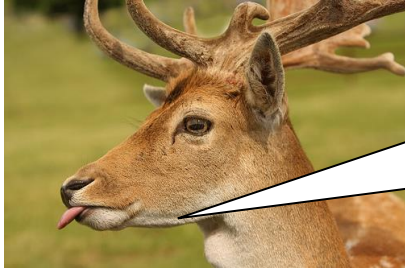

Food Bank – Kings Food Bank

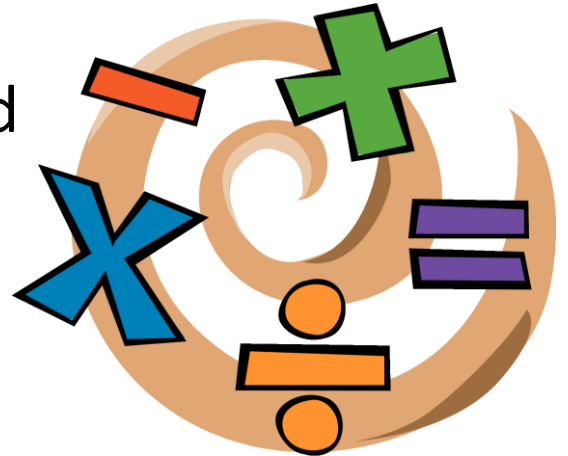
King's
