Year 3 and 4 Rugby



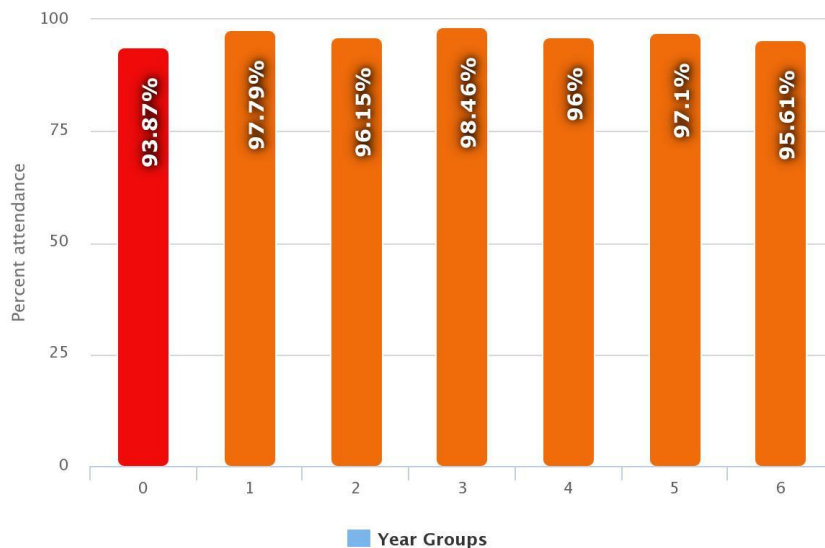
Well done to our two teams who had superb games at Casterton in wet and ultimately, muddy conditions – perfect for rugby! Well done to all who represented school last week.

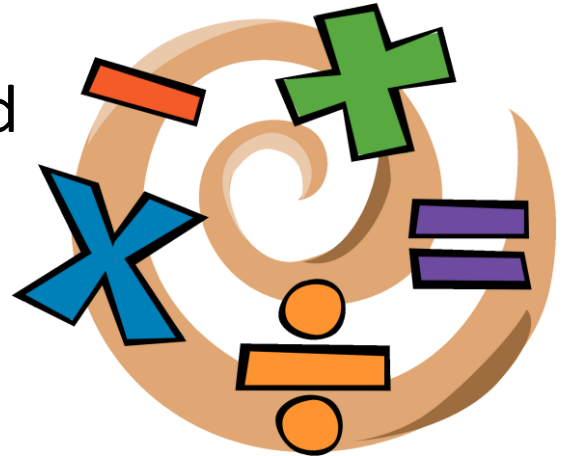
