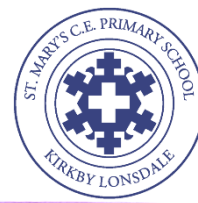

## PE Lessons and Elf Run



I was approached by a parent today who wanted to talk about PE in the rain in KS2. We discussed some concerns about doing PE in the rain and potential cold. After the discussion I thought I would mention this in our newsletter also. We have come to an understanding that we will always be safe in PE eg in icy/snowy conditions, storms and wind etc.. However we do go out in rain as we probably would not go out otherwise, being in the Lake District. As always, we expect children to have warm clothing and it is obviously advisable to have a waterproof. There will be times when PE kit comes home wet. You may wish to leave a spare pair of socks in the children's PE bag also.

Thankfully this doesn't happen too often but children do need to be ready for cold and wet weather. If parents do want to discuss this please get in touch with me via the school office or on the school yard – I am not on Facebook so can't respond to comments on social media. – Mr Jones.

On our Elf Run next Friday – (we will now be holding this in the morning). Children can come in appropriate running clothing/footwear. Children will need a full change of clothing which can be non uniform as we will expect wet weather. It should be a super morning and we have already arranged warm drinks and biscuits for the

children. Anyone with an allergy may want to send an appropriate snack for after the run. Please bring a suitable bag to take wet items home. Thank you.

Additional note:

Cross country club takes place on Fridays. The children who take part are reminded each week to bring spare socks each week as the conditions tend to be wet. This week we even needed to use the school shower to wash down muddy legs caked in mud—cross country know how to get stuck in whatever the conditions!
