## Arrival to school after Half Term

We are constantly having to review our procedures in light of covid-19 information and trying to be as practical as possible in school. With this in mind, we will be making the following changes after half term. Please tell relatives who will be dropping off and picking up.

- **Drop off:** Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and 2 will need to be dropped off at 8:45am and no earlier. With the exception of Nursery, all children in Year R-2 should arrive on the infant yard and be dropped off at the school the gate, when a staff member is there. Children will not be on the yard before 8:45am.
- **Pick up:** parents can come onto the yard but will be asked to be in different areas to wait for their children.  
**(Year 1 and 2 will no longer use the school garden)**
- **Year 3-6** will be as normal, however no children will be allowed on the yard before 8:30am.
