Design a new stamp to celebrate the Platinum Jubilee !

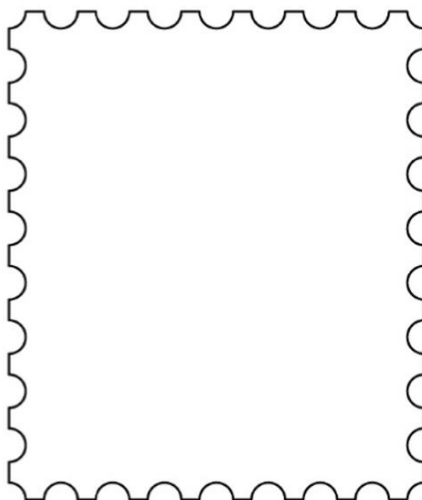
